Resolution of the Board of Directors
PARKING OF VEHICLES AND PODS

To clarify Article X, Section 6 of Arranmore HOA CC & R's, be it resolved that **unless special permission is secured from the Architectural committee:**

A. Recreational vehicles and the like belonging to Arranmore residents or family members, are to be parked in residents' driveways or garages. If the size of the vehicle or other circumstances make this impossible, it may be parked on the street in front of the resident's house for a maximum of 48 hours per month.

B. Recreational vehicles which belong to visitors/house guests and cannot be parked in driveway or garage, may be parked in front of the resident's house for a maximum of seven-nights during any six-month period.

C. Passenger cars, non-commercial pickup trucks, and motorcycles, currently licensed and in good repair, owned by Arranmore residents are to be parked in residents' driveways or garages. Permission is necessary if circumstances require parking on the street for more than 48 hours.

D. No commercial vehicle belonging to an Arranmore resident or family member shall be parked anywhere in Arranmore except inside an enclosed garage.

E. No vehicle shall be parked anywhere in Arranmore in a manner that obstructs access to any driveway or mail box. Parking in cul-de-sacs is prohibited if passage of a larger vehicle such as a garbage truck or fire engine is obstructed by the parked vehicle.

F. A moving pod may be parked in a resident's driveway or on the street in front of the resident's house for a period of one week.
